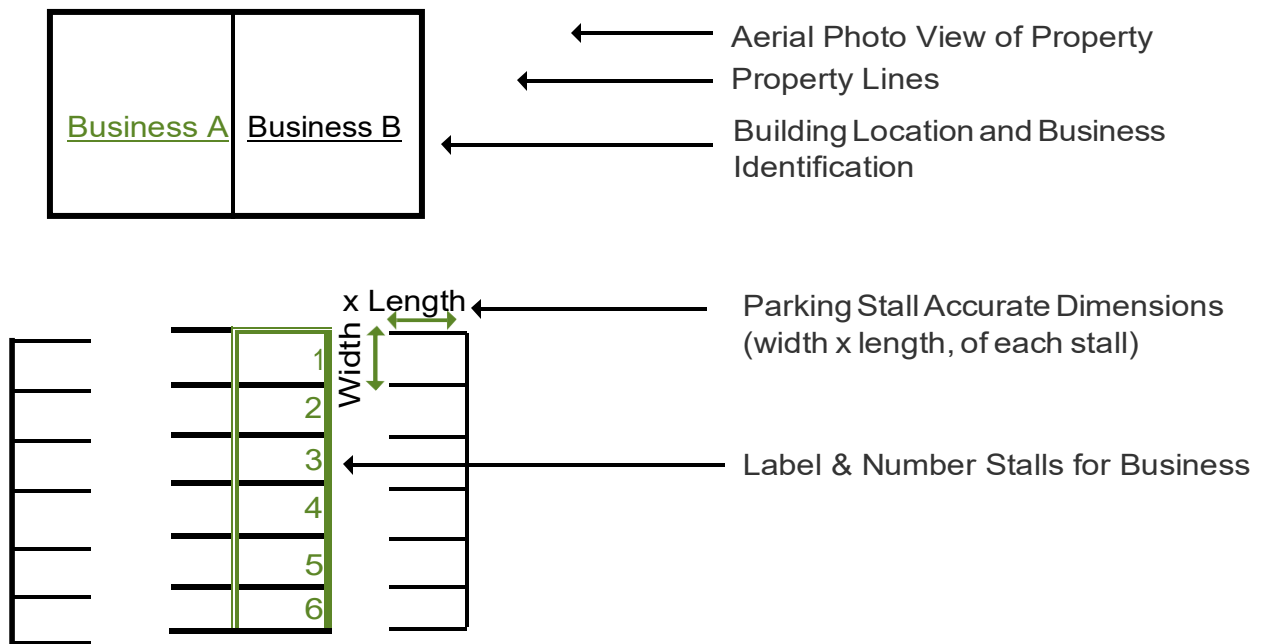


Example Site and Parking Plan



A Site and Parking Plan must be submitted with the Business License application. The City's [map viewer, WestMap](#), provides an aerial view option of your property, including property lines as well as drawing and measuring tools. The parking plan must have each dedicated stall outlined and labeled with accurate dimensions (length and width) to confirm the parking is sufficient to support the business.

Parking stalls must meet all of the requirements outlined in [Part 4 of the Zoning Bylaw](#) ** (including width, depth, and location).

The Site and Parking Plan must include the following items:

- Property lines
- Width and length dimensions of each parking stall for the Business
- Number of parking stalls as required**
- Building location and identify where business is located if in a multi-tenant building
- Label obstructions (ex. retaining walls, trees, utilities etc.)
