BYLAW NO. 0215

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A WATER DEVELOPEMNT COST CHARGE RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS Section 188 (2) (a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, as amended, requires local government to establish by bylaw reserve funds for the applicable purpose and direct that money be placed to the credit of the reserve fund; and

WHEREAS Section 566 (2)) of the *Local Government Act* authorizes the local government to provide for the expenditure of money in a reserve fund and interest earned on it for the purposes specified in the bylaw establishing the reserve fund.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of West Kelowna in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "CITY OF WEST KELOWNA WATER DEVELOPMENT COST CHARGE RESERVE FUND BYLAW NO. 0215, 2016".
2. There shall be and is hereby established a Reserve Fund under section 566 of the *Local Government Act* for the purpose of providing funds for providing, constructing, altering or expanding water facilities.
3. All interest earned from the money held in the Fund shall be deposited into its respective account
4. Money paid into the Fund may, until required to be used, be invested in the manner provided in the *Community Charter* for the investment of Municipal funds.
