The City of West Kelowna will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, Oct. 21, 2025 at 6 p.m.** in **Council Chambers at 3731 Old Okanagan Highway, West Kelowna, B.C.** to consider:

OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 0300.08 AND ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 0320.07 AND NO. 0320.08

Location: 2211 Campbell Road

Legal description: DISTRICT LOT 522, GROUP 1, ODYD, FR N D L 522

File number: Z 20-08.01

Purpose: Zoning application to rezone:

- from Low Density Multiple Residential Zone (R3) to Agricultural Zone (A1) for the western part of the property;
- from Intensive Water Use Zone (W2) to Recreational Water Use Zone (W1) for the eastern part of the property on the lake; and
- to remove site specific use 8.1.4 (f) and 6.2.4 in there entirety.

OCP amendment for the western side of the property from Medium Density Residential to Agricultural.

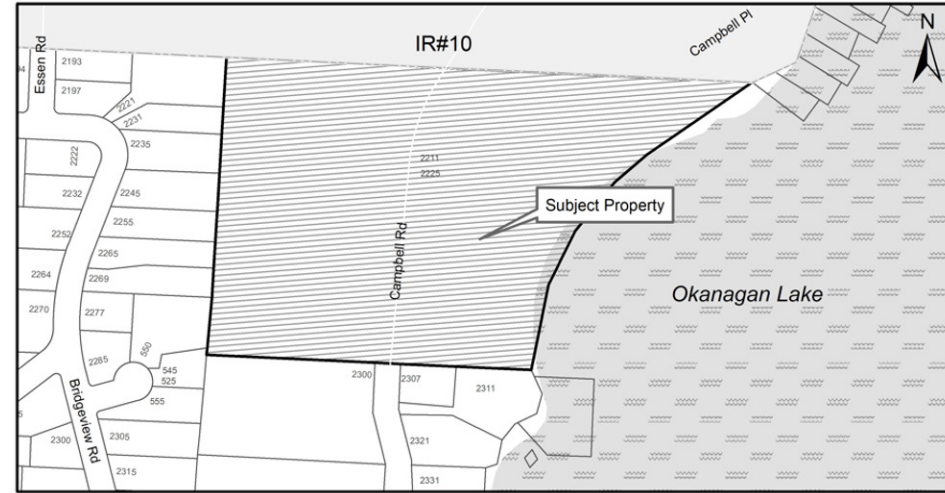
HOW TO MAKE A SUBMISSION
