## NOTICE OF PARCEL TAX ROLL

The City of West Kelowna roll of all properties subject to a parcel tax in 2020 has been prepared and will be made available electronically for inspection as requested. Please email [taxes@westkelownacity.ca](mailto:taxes@westkelownacity.ca) for instructions on how to view. An owner of property included on the Parcel Tax Roll may request an amendment by applying in writing to the City on or before the close of business Friday, April 17. An amendment may only be requested on one or more of the following grounds:

- There is an error or omission respecting a name or address on the parcel tax roll;
- There is an error or omission respecting the inclusion of a parcel;
- There is an error or omission respecting the charge levied;
- An exemption has been improperly allowed or disallowed.

The Parcel Tax Review Panel, consisting of three (3) members of Council, will convene at 5:45 p.m., Tuesday, April 21 at Council Chambers, 2760 Cameron Road, provided gathering size and social distancing space permit. The Panel will hear any complaints, make corrections as required and authenticate the roll. All property owners who file a written complaint to the Panel will be notified in writing of the decision. ## SANDBAGGING STATIONS SET UP

Crews have delivered sand and sandbags, to typical lakefront locations throughout the City of West Kelowna, should residents need to make any flood preparations later this season.



The City stocks these convenient locations as a precaution each year to help residents whose properties have been affected in the past by seasonal springtime flooding.

In keeping with COVID-19 prevention guidelines, please practice social distancing at the stations, bring your own shovels, wear gloves and adhere to all other health recommendations, such as hand washing and not touching your face. Stations are set up at the following locations:

- Beachnut Park at the corner of George Court and Whitworth Road.
- Hitchner Park at the corner of Hitchner and Jennens Roads.
- Fire Station No. 34 at the corner of Gates and Glenrosa Roads.
- Kinsmen Park at the southwestern corner of Shannon Lake and Asquith Roads.
- Fire Station No. 33 at 1805 Westlake Road.
- Casa Loma Beach, 2606 Casa Loma Road.
- Falcon Park, adjacent to 1339 Green Bay Road.
- Sternwheeler Park, adjacent to 1649 Pritchard Drive.
