West Kelowna's new Multi Sport Centre draws 700 users each week and offers family, youth and adult recreational programs and special events including soccer, fitness classes, holiday celebrations and tournaments.

The facility naming opportunity is ideal for a business, family or individual to expand their community involvement, support child and youth development and establish a legacy landmark.

The centre, located adjacent to Mar Jok Elementary School and Rosewood Sports Field, offers a Super 8 sized artificial field, 60m by 42m, which can be divided into halves or thirds. The dome is heated in winter, air conditioned in summer, offers universally accessible washrooms and has 32 paved and 72 overflow parking stalls.
