

GLENROSA/MCIVER UPGRADE DETOURS IN EFFECT



The first set of detours for the Glenrosa-McIver Road Upgrade project start May 14. Crews will close Glenrosa and McIver Roads for several months to realign the intersection and construct the first stage, which involves:

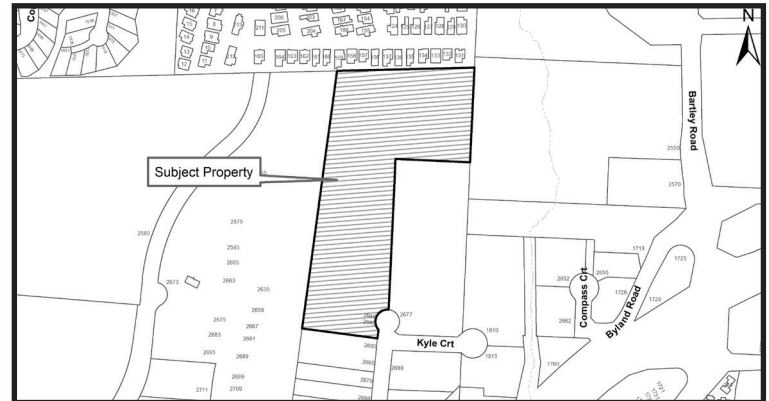
- Closure of Glenrosa Road at McIver Road until November.
- Rerouting access to the south side of Glenrosa Road through Yorkton.
- Rerouting access to the north side of Glenrosa Road through Webber-Gorman-McTaggart-McQueen-McGinnis.
- Placing barricades at the start of the closure area.
- Changing bus stop locations; for details please go online to bctransit.com/kelowna/schedules-and-maps.
- Providing safe passage for pedestrians.
- Re-opening the road if emergency evacuation is needed.
- Maintaining access for emergency vehicles and local traffic.
- Reducing speed limits to 30 km/hour on detour routes.

Crews will divide construction into three stages and allow closed sections to re-open after completion of each phase. The City will provide information on separate management plans at each stage. Submit in Writing

Send your written submissions to City Council by mail, email or by leaving it in the drop box outside the main doors of the Municipal Hall, 2760 Cameron Road. All submissions must be made Attn: City Clerk, File Number (Z 20-01) and must include your name and address by 4:00 p.m. on Monday May 25, 2020.

Any written submissions received prior to 10:00 a.m. May 19, 2020 will be included in the Council Agenda package. Any written submissions received after 10:00 a.m. May 19, 2020 and before 4:00 p.m. Monday, May 25, 2020, will be included as a Late Agenda Item. All submissions received before the close of the Public Hearing are provided to Council.

Attend in Person

If you require, the City is providing an option to attend the Public Hearing in person. The City will conduct the Public Hearing in accordance with the physical distancing requirements directed by provincial health authorities. Council will participate in the Public Hearing electronically and you may present to Council via web conference. To participate in-person, please attend at the date, time and address stated on this notice and staff will provide you with further instructions to participate safely.

Please note that Council cannot receive submissions after the conclusion of the Public Hearing.
