QUALIFICATIONS FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day (Oct. 15, 2022);
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR SCHOOL TRUSTEE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a School Trustee if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day (Oct. 15, 2022);
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified under the School Act or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding office as a trustee, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act, for the 2022 general local election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Mayor	\$29,953.49
Councillor	\$15,093.30
School Trustee	\$14,548.80

In accordance with the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act, for the 2022 general local election, the following third party advertising limits apply:

NOTICE OF PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENT

In accordance with Section 124(3) of the Community Charter, the City of West Kelowna intends to adopt "CITY OF WEST KELOWNA COUNCIL PROCEDURE AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 0258.02, 2022" (a bylaw to regulate the meetings of Council).

The purpose of the amendment is to adjust the meeting dates in May and August of each year. The proposed bylaw will see an additional Council meeting established on the third Tuesday of May (May will have 3 meetings) and will remove the first Council meeting in August (only one meeting will be held on the 4th Tuesday of the month).
