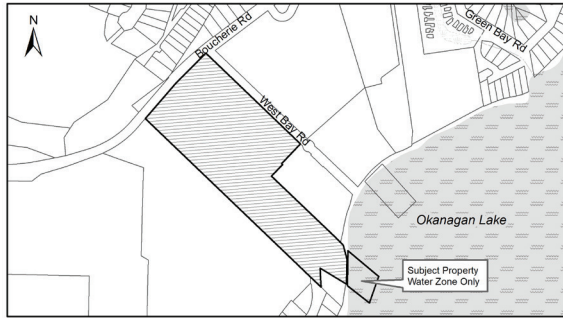
#### ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 154.112

- Location:** 3725 Boucherie Road, West Kelowna.  
**Legal description:** Lot A, DL 434, ODYD, Plan EPP105440.  
**File number:** Z 22-01.  
**Purpose:** To rezone the unsurveyed Crown land immediately abutting the upland agricultural parcel from Recreational Water Use Zone (W1) to Intensive Water Use Zone (W2) with additional text amendments to accommodate the commercial use of the existing dock.
