PROPERTY TAX REMINDER

Taxes and Home Owner Grant applications are due July 2

New for 2021, claim your Home Owner Grant with the Province of BC:

- a. Visit gov.bc.ca/homeownergrant; or,
- b. Call toll free 1-888-355-2700; and,
- c. Record the confirmation number after you complete your claim.

The Province of BC will send your confirmation to the City of West Kelowna so that you do not need to follow up with our staff.

Pay property taxes to the City and claim your Home Owner Grant with the Province of BC by 4:30 p.m. Friday, July 2 to avoid a late charge of 10 per cent. The penalty is applied statutorily July 3 to balances owing including unclaimed Home Owner Grant amounts and staff cannot reverse the charge.

Avoid lines and wait times by paying taxes:

- a. Online through your bank or credit union by selecting WEST KELOWNA - TAXES as the payee; use your roll number, without periods or spaces, as the account number and record the transaction confirmation number; or,
- b. By cheque, written out to City of West Kelowna, using the 24/7 drop box next to Municipal Hall's main entrance; include the remittance stub from your tax notice and place in an envelope before depositing.
