Learn about the City of West Kelowna's \$40 million COVID-19 resiliency-based capital budget designed to support Council's Strategic Priorities and keep our community moving forward. We aim to provide safe, clean drinking water, upgrade aging infrastructure and modernize our community to provide more active transportation options including roundabouts at Bartley and Shannon Lake Roads and Gellatly and Carrington Roads and sidewalk and cycling connections on Shannon Lake Road.

The proposed 4.05 per cent increase includes a one per cent levy specifically for infrastructure investment.
