

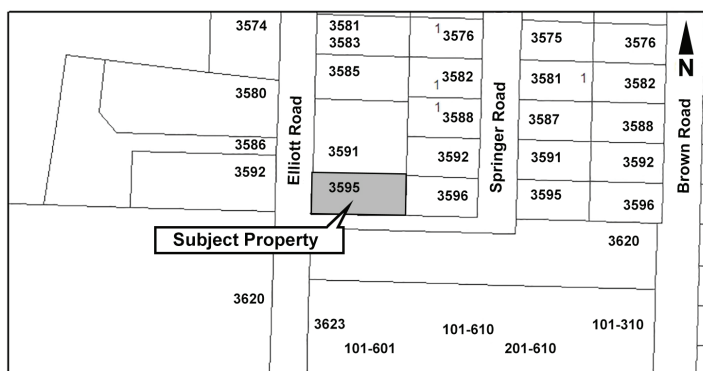

Purpose: Site specific text amendment (rezoning) to permit live-work unit use in a Neighbourhood Commercial (C2) Zone on the condition that parking requirements for commercial and residential uses are calculated separately

Submit in writing

Make submissions Attn: City Clerk, File No. Z 21-08 and include your name and address and submit by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, Jan. 24, 2022. Written submissions can be provided to Council in advance of the scheduled public hearing date via:

3. **In-Person** by leaving your submission with reception or in the drop box outside the main doors of Municipal Hall at 2760 Cameron Road.

Written submissions received before 4:00 p.m. Monday, Jan. 24, 2022, will be provided to Council as part of the publicly posted Agenda. All submissions received before the close of the Public Hearing are provided to Council and become part of the public record. **Council cannot receive submissions after the conclusion of the Public Hearing.**

In accordance with COVID-19 protocols, West Kelowna City Council Meetings will provide limited seating based on Public Health Orders, which will be on a first come, first serve basis. The City will provide participation by phone as follows:

Staff will be unable to provide you with a specific time-slot, so participants must be available to address Council by phone for the duration of the Public Hearing starting at 6:00 p.m.
