Welcome to the new Rose Valley Water Treatment Plant

The City of West Kelowna is excited to announce that all former Rose Valley - Lakeview System, Sunnyside/Pritchard and West Kelowna Estates users are now receiving clean, safe, and reliable drinking water from the new Rose Valley Water Treatment Plant service.

Water is now being delivered from the new plant to an estimated 19,650 water system users in the City. Users in the former Rose Valley – Lakeview System received water from the new plant in Phase 1, in November. In Phase 2, users in the former West Kelowna Estates and Sunnyside/Pritchard Water Systems, began receiving water from the new water treatment plant effective Dec. 12 and Dec. 20 respectively.



PROVIDING WATER IN TWO PHASES (NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER 2023)

Phase I – Rose Valley-Lakeview System

Phase II – West Kelowna Estates System and Sunnyside/Pritchard System

- Water Provided Prior to the End of December 2023 - completed!
