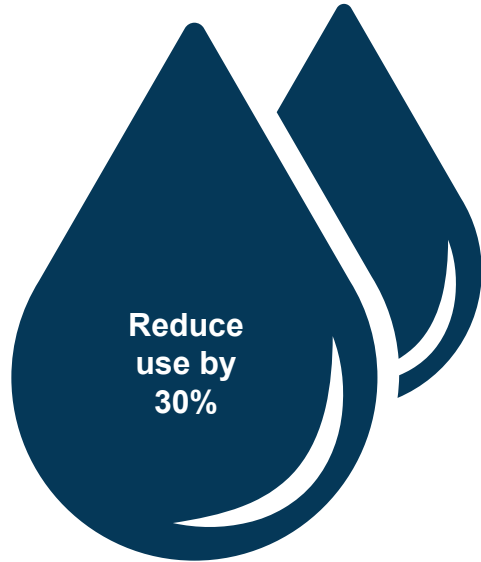

## WATER RESTRICTIONS - STAGE 2



### Conserve now - water reserves are limited

West Kelowna's reservoir levels continue to decline due to high irrigation use during ongoing drought and extreme heat; the City reminds water customers that Stage 2 restrictions, allowing twice weekly watering, are now in effect.

Residential, commercial and agricultural customers are asked to reduce outdoor use by 30 per cent. Conserving now will help the City manage limited resources. With little rain and a heatwave, upland storage may reach a point where the snowpack is insufficient to replenish reservoir levels next year. Find helpful tips for making water work more effectively at [westkelownacity.ca/wateringregulations](http://westkelownacity.ca/wateringregulations). Stage 2 restrictions are:

- Even numbered addresses water Saturdays and Tuesdays
- Odd numbered addresses water Sundays and Wednesdays
- Properties equipped with automated sprinkler systems water between midnight and 6 a.m. on permitted days.
- Properties equipped with manually controlled sprinkling systems, including those attached to outside taps, water between midnight and 11 a.m. or 6 p.m. to midnight on permitted days
- Never water between 11 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- General rules allow additional hand watering of landscape plants and vegetable gardens, excluding lawns, as needed
