COVID 19 ARENA USE PROCEDURES

(Updated March 8, 2021)

General Information

- All participants must abide by federal, provincial, municipal, and organizational COVID-19 safety plans/orders.
- Maintain social distance of three metres. Stay home if sick or feeling unwell. Wear masks. Wash hands.
- Have fun! 😊

Entrance Rules

- As of Nov. 3, everyone must wear masks when inside City facilities.
- Users must use designated entrance and exit locations.
- Arrive on time - facility access for participants is limited to 15 minutes prior to the rental.
- A COVID Ambassador must assist every group with accessing facilities and managing occupancy limits.
- Wait outside the building until your COVID Ambassador has arrived.
- Arena staff will only open doors for the COVID Ambassador.
- Arena staff will open doors 15 minutes prior to the ice rental.
- Doors must remain locked at all times.

Change Area Rules

- As of Oct. 18, participants may change inside the arena dressing rooms.
- Wear masks at all times when inside dressing rooms.
- Wear undergarments at all times - nudity is prohibited in designated changing areas.
- As of February 19, participants may use the toilets inside the dressing rooms.
- Showers are off limits until further notice.
- Participants must leave clothing and bags at designated seating locations as they take the ice.
- All participants must vacate the facility **within 10 minutes** after rental has ended so that staff can prep, clean and disinfect areas for the next user group.

On Ice Rules

- **As of Dec 4, PHO orders restrict all game play or cohort activity.** Users must limit activity to skills development and drills while maintaining 3 metres distance between players and coaches.
- All participants must remain a minimum of three metres apart when outside the field of play.
- No equipment sharing.
- At the end of the session, participants must exit the ice on time so that the next group can start as scheduled.

Miscellaneous Rules

- The City permits one responsible adult per participant to act as a support person, if required, for all children who are 9-years-old and younger.
- The City allows one responsible adult per participant who requires special assistance.
- The City permits essential event personnel inside the facility. This includes but is not limited to players, coaches, referees, timekeepers, scorekeepers, music technicians, TV and radio broadcasters, team managers and trainers, first aid attendants, COVID Ambassadors, etc.
- No event can exceed 65 personnel, as per BC Recreation and Parks Association recommendations.
- No spitting anywhere on or off the ice.
- **Sanitization of the arena spaces will occur periodically. Wash your hands.**
