Glenrosa-McIver Road Upgrade - Stage 2 begins

The second stage for Glenrosa-McIver Road improvements starts next week and two detour changes are scheduled.

Sep. 8 at 7 a.m. Glenrosa Road from McIver to McGinnis Roads will be closed to thru traffic until mid-November to accommodate road upgrades and safety improvements including sidewalks, cycling lanes, curbs and gutters and final paving.

An interim road closure will be in place starting Mon. Sep. 14 to Sat. Sep. 26 at the intersection of McGinnis and Glenrosa roads for the removal of rock material. WATER NOTICE

Planned Boil Water Notice and no outdoor water use

Starting Sep. 8, a Boil Water Notice and no outdoor irrigation is required for the Lakeview-Rose Valley System, for up to one week, for civil works for Rose Valley Water Treatment Plant.

These works will reduce by 40 per cent the amount of water available throughout the Lakeview-Rose Valley System. To ensure water is available for boiling, cooking, laundry and bathing, no automatic or underground irrigation use, domesticly or agriculturally, is required until Sat. Sep. 12 at 12 p.m. Hand watering of flower beds and gardens is allowed. Visit westkelownacity.com/rvwtp for further details.
