Final property tax deadline Sep. 30

Those who have not yet paid their 2020 property taxes and claimed their Home Owner Grants are reminded to do so by Sep. 30, in order to avoid a 10 per cent late payment penalty, which will be applied Oct. 1. The property tax due date was July 2, however Council deferred charging the late penalty to help those facing financial hardships due to COVID-19. 2020 Tax Sale deferred

As per Section 254 of the Community Charter, and Division 7 of the Local Government Act, all properties with delinquent taxes are subject to Tax Sale. Due to COVID-19, and as per provincial Ministerial Order No. M159, Council has deferred the 2020 tax sale to Sep. 27, 2021. Those financially affected by COVID-19 should create a payment plan with the City to avoid their properties being subject to Tax Sale in 2021. Glenrosa-McIver Road Upgrade - Stage 2 begins

The second stage for Glenrosa-McIver Road improvements have begun and two detour changes are scheduled. An interim road closure is in place until Sat. Sep. 26 at the intersection of McGinnis and Glenrosa roads for the removal of rock. A detour route from McIver to Gates Roads is in effect during this time only. From Sep. 28 until approximately mid-November, Glenrosa Road from McIver to McGinnis Roads will be closed to thru traffic to accommodate road upgrades and safety improvements such as sidewalks, bike lanes, curbs, gutters and final paving.
