COVID 19 SPORT DOME USE PROCEDURES

(Updated November 23, 2020)

General Information

- All participants must abide by federal, provincial, municipal, and organizational COVID-19 safety plans/orders.
- Maintain social distance of two metres. Stay home if sick or feeling unwell. Wear masks. Wash hands.
- Have fun! 😊

Entrance Rules

- As of Nov. 3, everyone must wear masks when inside City facilities.
- Doors must remain locked at all times.
- Arrive on time - facility access for participants is limited to 15 minutes prior to the rental.
- A COVID Ambassador must assist every group with accessing facilities and managing occupancy limits.
- Wait outside the building until your COVID Ambassador has arrived.
- All participants are to arrive fully dressed for play, including proper footwear.
- Everyone entering the facility must sanitize their hands and clean their footwear, prior to entering the facility.
- In winter, participants must use designated spots in the facility to change into turf footwear.
- Social distance outside the entrance area and enter facility one at a time through the rotating door.
- As of November 19th, no spectators allowed, as per Provincial Health Officer Order.
- The City permits one responsible adult per participant inside the building to assist the participant in getting ready for the activity.
- The support person will need to leave the facility after they have assisted the participant.
- No spitting anywhere inside the facility.

On-Field Procedure

- All participants must remain a minimum of two meters apart during all uses unless the organizer has submitted a plan that abides by the Provincial Health Officer and Via Sport's guidelines related to game play and cohorts and if City staff can accommodate the plan.
- Users must limit use to skills development and drills only, unless they have submitted an approved game play or cohort plan and the City has confirmed the accommodation.
- No sharing of equipment. All equipment must be sanitized before and after the session.

Exit Building Procedure

- At the end of the session, participants must leave the field immediately so that the next group can start on time.
- Everyone must sanitize their hands, prior to leaving the building through the rotating doors.

Washrooms

- Will be open and available for use. Anyone departing the facility to go to the washrooms must sanitize their hands prior to leaving through the rotating door and upon return to the facility.

Miscellaneous Rules

- The City will continue to permit essential event personnel inside the facility. This includes but is not limited to players, coaches, referees, time keepers, score keepers, , team managers, team trainers, first aid attendants, door ambassadors, etc.
- As recommended by the BCRPA, at no time will a single event exceed 65 personnel.

Sanitization of the arena spaces will only occur periodically. Please wash your hands.
