Holiday closures and essential services guide

The City's administrative offices, including Municipal Hall, will close for the holidays at 1:00 p.m. Dec. 24 and reopen 8:30 a.m. Jan. 4, 2021.

Emergency and essential services such as fire/rescue, policing, water and sewer and winter roads maintenance will continue. Curbside waste will be collected on its usual schedule in the City of West Kelowna. Transit will run on a Sunday schedule Christmas Day, Dec. 25 and New Year's Day, Jan. 1 and on the usual schedule for all other days including Christmas Eve, Dec. 24 and New Year's Eve, Dec. 31.
