Additional general information

WHY

It's about the best option to pay for water service. It's not about whether the RVWTP will be built.

WHO

Property owners in the future service area: Lakeview-Rose Valley, Pritchard, Sunnyside and West Kelowna Estates.

WHAT

The preferred method for borrowing of up to \$23.5 million to design, build and finance the RVWTP.

HOW

A legislative process is underway. If long term borrowing is not preferred, property owners must sign and return the petition.

HOW MUCH

RVWTP service area users currently pay \$116 per year. We need to reach \$150 per year in 2022. After the \$34 increase, no further annual increases will be needed to design, build and finance the plant.

AGREE WITH RECOMMENDED LONG-TERM BORROWING?

Do nothing and we will contact you in 2022.

OPPOSE LONG-TERM BORROWING?

Complete the Petition Against Form, enclose in envelope provided and mail or hand deliver within the 30-day period indicated on the form. If Council receives sufficient petitions against for the proposed local area service, long-term borrowing will no longer be an option. One of the two short-term options noted below to service the up to \$23.5 million funds required (estimated in 2022), will be brought forward for Council's consideration:



1) 5-Year - Each parcel within the RVWTP local service area pay \$600 annually for 5-years or \$2,815 lump sum

OR



2) One-time payment - Proceed with a single one-time payment of \$2,815 (estimated in 2022) per parcel within the RVWTP local area service
