



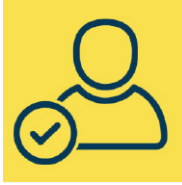

QUALIFICATIONS FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day Oct. 17, 2026;
- B.C. resident for at least six months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed Sept. 1 to Sept. 11, 2026; and
- Not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in a B.C. election or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR SCHOOL TRUSTEE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a School Trustee if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day Oct. 17, 2026;
- B.C. resident for at least six months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed Sept. 1 to Sept. 11, 2026; and
- Not disqualified under the *School Act* or any other enactment from voting in a B.C. election or being nominated for, being elected to or holding office as a trustee, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 general local election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Trustee	\$1,107.65
